



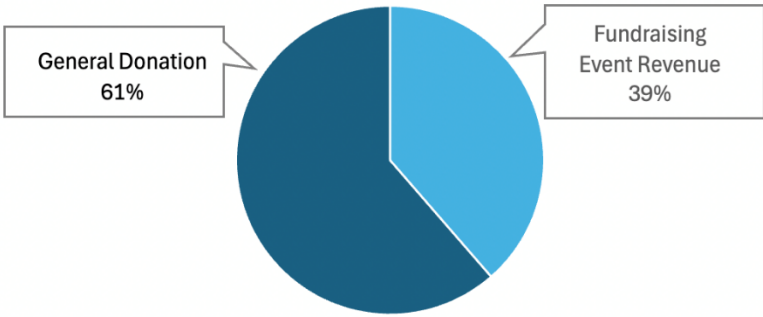
On sunny June 23, 2024, **NepalAbility** resumed our first in-person fundraiser since 2019. Over 110 tickets were sold. The Garden Fête & Silent Auction fundraiser raised \$11,055.86. In 2024, Veritas once again supported a double-the-donation campaign with thanks to an anonymous donor. Along with our generous donors throughout the year, an additional \$17,584.36 was raised, totalled to \$28,335.38 funds raised in 2024.

Team 26 was an all-Occupational Therapists team that specialized in Paediatric Rehabilitation. From across Ontario and Quebec, Canada, Becky Bauman, Sue Wahl, Shirley Button, and Zoe Lavallee travelled to teach in Nepal in March 2024. They taught with both our partners: United Mission Hospital Tansen (UMHT) and Green Pastures Hospital (GPH), Nepal.

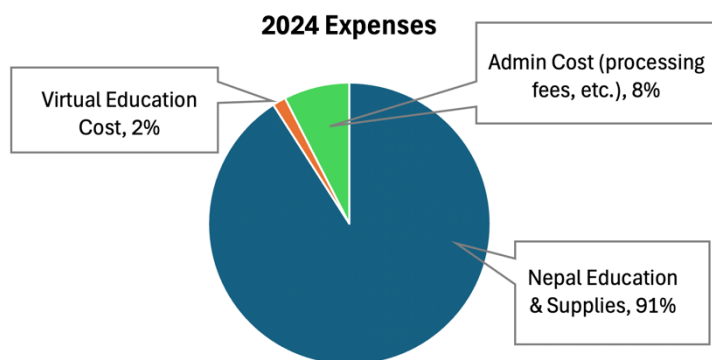
In addition to teaching therapists as they supported children and their parents, they did formal education sessions on various topics including Autism Treatment Approaches, Positive Strategies for Challenging Behaviours, and Augmentative Alternative Communication. As per request from GPH’s therapy team, they also covered Sensory Integration and Praxis assessment approaches. The team also delivered various paediatric therapy supplies as per requests from both UMHT and GPH.



Team 26 therapists paid their own travel expenses and donated their time to teach and share their expertise to support health care providers, children, and parents in Nepal. Expenses to support learning and the delivery of rehab, such as equipment and costs to do community patient visits, were covered by NepalAbility with many thanks to our generous donors.

As in previous years, \$12,100.00CAD was given to UMHT. This funding supported 52 patients with financial needs in receiving rehabilitation services and therapeutic equipment.

91% of 2024 expenses were directly used to support rehab services and education in Nepal. Processing fees to support online ticket and silent auction sales and donations raised the administration cost to 8%.
